I have seen your letter of 21 February to Patrick Jenkin about the closure programme for 405-line transmitters.

I must accept the economic arguments which you put forward but in the interests of the Northern Ireland users affected (who are pro-rata a high number) would press for extension for the programme of bringing in UHF services as quickly as possible.
